Pre-K classes use the research-based Opening the World of Learning (OWL) curriculum that focuses on early language-literacy development. The OWL format coupled with a strong partnership with the Atlanta Speech School's Rollins Center makes the Cox Pre-K program a model for early learning programs across the country.


